



Seaguar Knot








Form a loop in the line and in the leader and hold loops side by side.




Insert index finger into loops and make 3 full counter-wise twists.




Step 3

Hold loops open and feed tag end of line and leader through the loop.






Lubricate line and pull all four ends to cinch the knot forming a figure eight.



Step 5

Pull tag ends to and leader and line to fully tighten.



Step 6

Trim the tag ends.

Uses: This knot is easy to tie and reliable. It is a good choice for joining fluorocarbon leaders to monofilament and superbraid line.

Tying it: Anglers with large hands or weak eyes may consider using a pen style brass knot tier to assist in tying this knot.

Advantages: It retains a high percentage of main-line strength and has a wind-on profile—great when using long, low-visibility leaders.
